Terrain Park is a seasonal position. Terrain Park Staff are responsible for the safe operation of the Terrain Park areas as well as overall hill safety. They spend their days monitoring behavior of the guests within the Terrain Park areas and maintaining all features to the highest level in all types of weather. Park builds are done overnight, or early mornings, so they must be flexible in their schedule and availability. As a result, enjoyment of the outdoors is a must! The Terrain Park staff must be physically fit as there is considerable lifting, shoveling, and hiking within the Terrain Park areas and surrounding slopes. The Terrain Park Staff hold guest safety in highest regard and must be always diligent and responsible.

DUTIES

- Provide excellent customer service and create positive memories for the guests
- Build and maintain the Terrain Park areas to the highest level
- Ensure that all signs and fences are installed correctly daily, and that the Terrain Park log is filled out correctly at the beginning of each shift
- Monitor guest behavior and provide instruction when needed
- Monitor all signs, fences, safety features on the general skiing terrain and maintain to the highest level of safety for our guests
- Assist the lift staff where required
- Always having a smile and hello for our guests
